

GOVERNMENT SUPPORT TO ENCOURAGE RECRUITMENT

AN OVERVIEW FROM TRS TRAINING



APPRENTICESHIPS

Employers are paid up to £4000 for every NEW apprentice recruited before 30 Sept 2021. That is, £3000 for every apprentice PLUS an extra £1000 if the apprentice is aged 16 to 18 (or aged under 25 with an education, health and care plan or who has been in the care of their local authority). Paid in two instalments. Employers must open an apprenticeship service account if they don't have one.

KICKSTART

The Government funds six months' salary of 16 to 24 year olds taken on before the end of 2021 who are at risk of unemployment. The subsidy covers 100% National Minimum Wage, NI & employer minimum automatic enrolment contributions for 25 hrs a week. Employers may top this up. Additional funding is available for training and supporting candidates. Once Kickstart candidates complete their placement, they can progress onto an Apprenticeship.

TRAINEESHIPS

Employers can claim £1000 for each 16 to 24 year old they provide a work experience placement for as part of a Traineeship delivered by a learning provider. The placements must be for at least 70 hours and the funding can be used to cover costs such as travel or uniform. Up to a maximum of £10K per employer. The Traineeship must be completed before 31 July 2021.
