GROOMING.

Grooming is when somebody builds a relationship with somebody else with the aim of exploiting them later on. Sexual abuse of children normally starts with a grooming process. People with extremist views often look to groom others.





Grooming can happen online or in the real world. The person may or may not be a stranger to you. They could be any age and male or female. They might also not be who they say they are.

## THINGS TO WATCH FOR

Signs of being groomed include:

- Being asked personal questions.
- Somebody paying you lots of attention.
  - Being offered gifts.
  - Being asked to meet people you first met online.
  - Being asked to do things you're uncomfortable with.

## WHAT TO DO

Be suspicious! If you think that you, or somebody you know, is being groomed then tell someone, e.g. a parent or teacher. You can also use the Click CEOP website to stop grooming.
